Yes, if you choose any other colour rather than 'standard white', a colour internally or externally there usually is an extra cost involved.

What is a Wood Grain Foil

It is a foil finish applied to a PVC window. It usually replicates the colour and most importantly the texture of wood from a particular series of timber.

Will my windows look exactly like the windows in showrooms?

The only difference will be the internal finish, our showroom cils have been either varnished or had a coat of paint, speak to our Sales Consultant to ensure you get the perfect finish to complement your windows.

What will happen to my old windows?

Sidey's products are 100% recyclable; your old windows will be removed and returned to our recycling centre.

The Survey Stage

Your contract is checked and signed and your deposit payment processed, we then pass to our Survey Team. We will schedule an appointment for one of our surveyors to come to your home to double check the measurements for your windows to ensure the installation process is seamless and no final amendments are required.

If any amendments are required you will be contacted by your Sales Consultant who will fully explain any variations to the original contract and the reasoning behind it. A 'variation form' will then be issued, confirming updated changes and confirming any increase or decrease in the original contract value.

Final Payments/Sign Off

Once the windows have been installed, a member of the Installation Team will go round every newly installed window and show you how they operate. You will be asked to inspect their work and the units fitted and to sign the final Inspection Certificate.

If there is anything that still requires to be done, this will be marked on this for returning on the office for attention by our admin team. Payments will then be requested. We accept cash and cheque payments, or you can call our office staff who can process a debit or credit payment.


